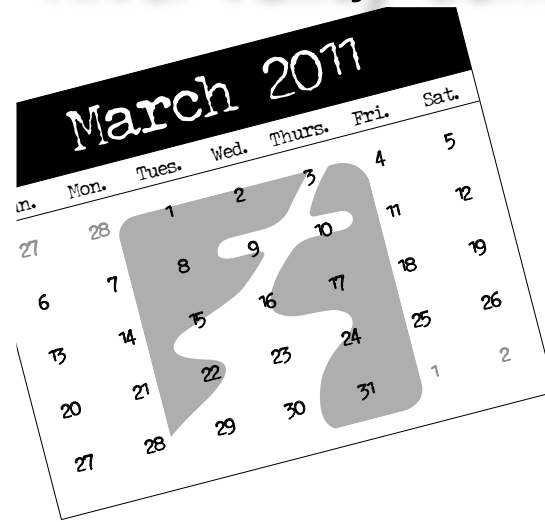
The Blessing:
